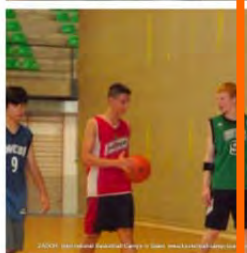

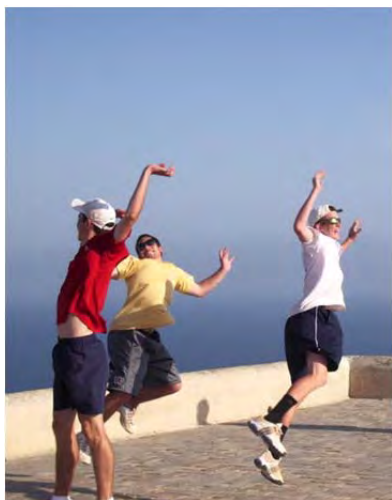

This Basketball Skills Development Camp for boys and girls includes: basketball lectures, individual technique training circuits and workshops focused on shooting and developing teamwork from one-on-one to five-on-five.

## Language course in small groups

Spanish or English immersion courses for teenagers make use of an active, practical and communicative methodology to guarantee that students learn as fast and effectively as possible.

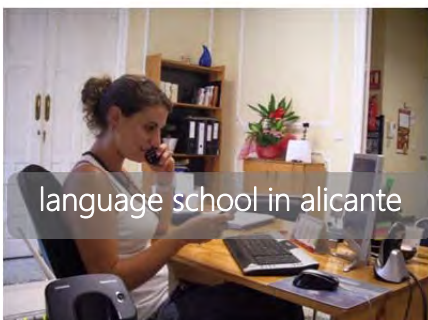

Located in the south of the Valencia region, Alicante is 185 km from Valencia, 60 km from Elche, 515 km from Barcelona and 422 km from Madrid.

### Places to visit

Santa Barbara Castle, one of the largest medieval fortresses in Europe, the City Hall, San Nicolas Co-cathedral, the Bonfire Museum, the Crib Museum, Archaeological Museum (MARQ), the Gavina Palace, a variety of 18th century manor houses and the seafront.

### Surrounding cities

The largest city is Valencia, with the architecturally impressive City of Arts and Sciences, only an hour and a half away; Elche, where you can walk around the largest palm tree forest in Europe; and Villajoyosa with its Chocolate Museum. Jijona and Altea are also cities not to be missed.

## Basketball development

An international basketball camp in Spanish and English, with coaches and assistants from Spain, Serbia and the USA.

This is a Development Basketball Camp for campers from the age of 14 to 17 who already have a minimum of 4-5 years of playing experience.

An average of 4 hours per day is devoted to basketball: basketball lectures, training focused on individual technique, group training and competitions.

Intense training with a variety of teaching techniques is used to achieve optimum results.

A Development Basketball Camp for players aged 14 to 17 who already have experience in playing basketball (minimum 4-5 years) with a ratio of 1 coach per 6-8 players to ensure participants receive personalised training and support.

**Basketball training objectives**

The camp will develop both individual and team techniques. Competitions are important, but not as much as developing individual basketball skills.

The camp is designed for players who seriously want to improve their game.

**Basketball coaches and assistants**

David Gil, senior basketball coach and assistant coach in the ACB-Spanish League, is the sports consultant in charge of planning training sessions. Camp coaches include Mladen Jegdic, FIBA senior coach; Shay Miller West, professional basketball player; Sabino Suárez, senior coach and other senior coaches.

## quick facts about Basketball

*Training sessions are conducted in Spanish and English...*

An average 4 hours of intense workout per day Monday to Friday to improve your technique and get results.

### Basketball lectures

On several days training starts or ends with basketball lectures covering a wide variety of topics: learn by watching a basketball match; the pros and cons of being a basketball player; work and succeed; or shooting training and group training.

### Individual technique stations

Focus on fundamentals of the game:

- Intense ball handling drills
- Shooting off the dribble
- Pass and play
- Receptions
- Playing without the ball
- Defense balance, defense pressure

### Dribble & Shoot stations

Drills in real shooting situations designed to correct mistakes, improve technique and to help players perfect their skills: free throws, three-pointers, pull up jump shots, step back jump shots, spin moves, euro step, etc.

### Teamwork in basketball

Stations to develop teamwork with focus on reading the defense; passing situations; use of locks; and 1 on 1, 2 on 2, 3 on 3 and 4 on 4 games and competitions.

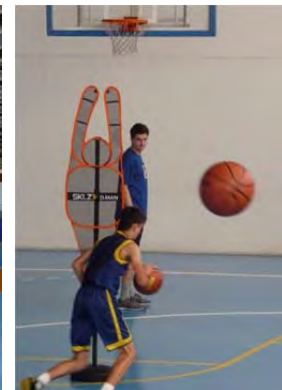

## Basketball facilities

Players train every morning in a semi-indoor sports hall or in an indoor basketball court depending on the weather conditions. The basketball facilities are carefully selected to ensure the best conditions for players and avoid the heat and humidity of the summer months on the Mediterranean coast.

2 Sports Halls (12 hoops) near the hotel 10 or 15 minutes walking.

Provided transports when needed.

Both venues have female and male changing rooms and toilets, and comply with all safety requirements established by law.

## Language course

From Monday to Friday, participants have three English or Spanish classes per day with experienced teachers.

Language courses are specifically designed for teenagers and make use of an active, practical and communicative methodology to guarantee that students learn as quickly and effectively as possible.

Lessons are in small groups with a maximum of 7 students per classroom to ensure that students receive personalised teaching.

Although students work on a variety of language skills including speaking and fluency, listening and reading comprehension and writing, the predominant focus is on communication skills.

## quick facts about the course

*12.5 hours per week: Spanish for foreigners and English for Spanish speaking players...*

Focusing on both oral and written comprehension and expression, the priority is developing communication skills.

### Communicative approach

Oral skills are emphasised with lessons structured around continuously practicing the vocabulary, grammar and communicative functions that are most important in day-to-day life.



### Lessons in small groups

In order to learn how to speak fluently, language classes are always in small groups with personalised teaching, active and dynamic class participation and maximum class interaction.

*Language classes are entirely in Spanish or English, so that teens are immersed in the language...*

Language courses with 3 lessons per day from Monday to Friday to start learning or improve Spanish or English skills.

**Various levels**

Language lessons are available from Beginner to Advanced levels. On the first day of the course, students take a written test and have oral interview with the teacher responsible for level placement.

**International atmosphere**

Our aim is not only to teach another language but to introduce teens from different countries to each other to discuss and compare their lives, issues and concerns while speaking a new language.

**Wide range of topics**

The content of the classes varies in accordance with the age of participants and their level. Basketball vocabulary is also included to allow participants to be able to understand their coaches.

**Class material**

Students are provided with materials for each class, but they must bring their own notebook, pens, pencils and pocket dictionary.

The language centre is very well situated, 7-10 minutes on foot from

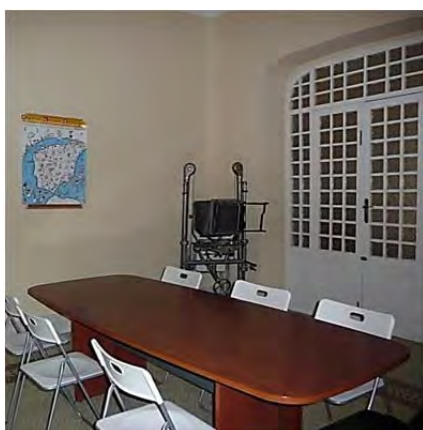
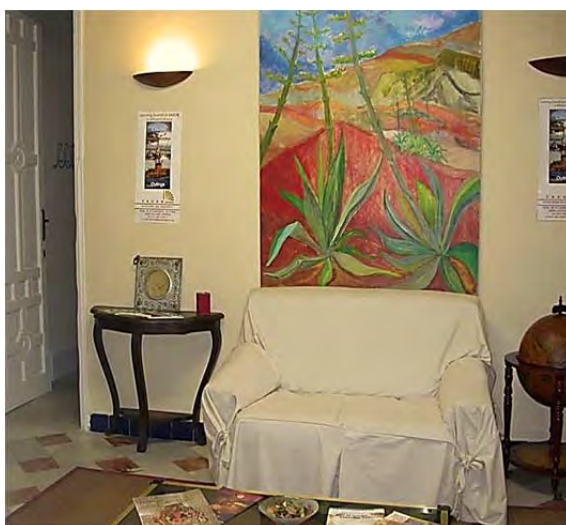
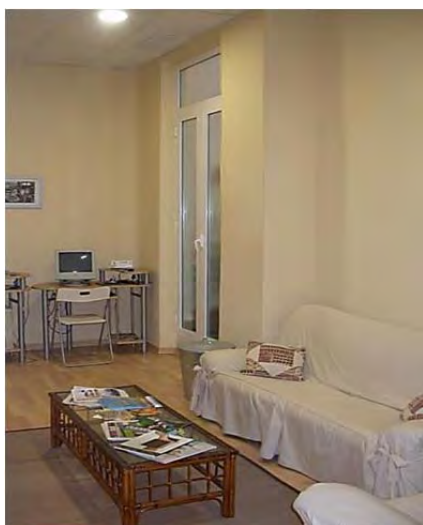
the beach, in a very dynamic and commercial area of Alicante.

Players staying overnight live in twin or triple rooms in Hotel Kris Maya. All rooms are equipped with air-conditioning and WIFI internet connection.

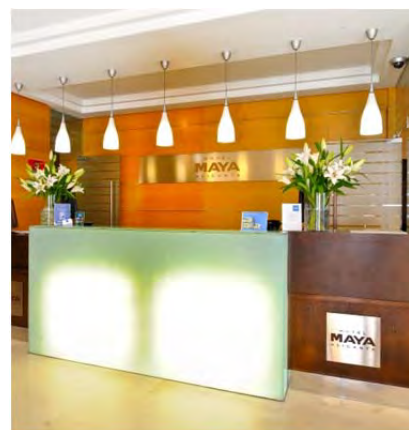

Hotel Kris Maya Alicante is located at the feet of the famous Santa Bárbara Castle, the beach only a pleasant 5-minute walk away and 15 minutes walking from the basketball courts.

### Quality facilities

All rooms are exterior-facing and are exceptionally bright. Each room has a fully-equipped bathroom, WIFI Internet connection, TV, and air-conditioning.

These 18 square metre rooms are fully-furnished with 2 or 3 beds, wardrobe, and study desk.

### Full board accommodation

From Monday to Friday participants have full board meals consisting of daily buffet-style breakfast, lunch and dinner. At the weekend players have breakfast and an evening meal at the hotel and are provided with a packed lunch to take on excursions.

## Private insurance

All participants are covered by a health, accident, travel and civil liability insurance included in the camp fees.

This medical assistance, with one of the highest coverage limits on the market, covers:

- Illnesses or accidents, with repatriation and relocation to country of origin

- Travel and baggage delays
- Search for and localization of lost baggage
- Compensation in cases of stolen baggage
- Loss of services previously contracted
- Accidents while travelling in Spain

If required, participants may opt to purchase a cancellation insurance policy.

*Please do not hesitate to ask for insurance policy and cancellation insurance details...*

In case of emergency, Zador staff will immediately contact the person indicated at enrolment.

### Insurance policy

Zador purchases a private insurance for every student and acts merely as an intermediary between the insurance company and the student. A copy of the policy will be sent to parents /guardians.

### Procedure in case of illness

As stated in the parental permission form, if a minor requires medical treatment, a physiotherapist/nurse will provide appropriate medical care during the camp programme.

If campers are seriously ill or injured, they will be taken to the hospital or an ambulance will be called. In less severe circumstances, campers will be immediately taken to a doctor indicated by the insurance company. In both cases, Zador staff will immediately contact parents and/or guardians.

### Cancellation insurance

If desired, participants may purchase an optional cancellation insurance policy. Cancellation insurance must be purchased at the time of reservation and payment.

## Optional **Transfer service**

Alicante has excellent connections with other cities in Spain and Europe.

Alicante airport (El Altet) is located 11 km from Alicante and it is about 30 min from the airport to the city centre. Transfer service from Alicante airport, bus/coach or train station is NOT included in the package price.

Upon request, a pick-up service is available from the airport, train or bus/coach station.

The cost for this service varies depending on the time and place of arrival or departure as well as the age of the participant and if he/she is flying as an unaccompanied minor (UM).

The conditions under which airlines accept unaccompanied minors vary. It is always important to check directly with the carrier before booking the flights.

Arrival  
"normal" transfer

As Alicante airport and the train and bus/coach stations are small, campers will quickly see a person with a name sign waiting at the terminal exit (only one in Alicante airport).

Arrival  
transfer for UM

Please inform us if the camper will travel as an unaccompanied minor (UM) in order to organise the pick-up and drop-off service. Please take into account that if you do not notify us, the airline will not allow your child to leave the terminal.

Departure  
"normal" transfer

Campers must leave the hotel 3 hours before their flight, 2 hours before their train or 1 hour before their bus/coach departure. Please, take these times into account when booking the tickets. A person working on behalf of Zador will accompany your child during check-in.

Departure  
transfer for UM

The name, address, phone number and passport number of the person picking up the minor at the destination airport must be provided.

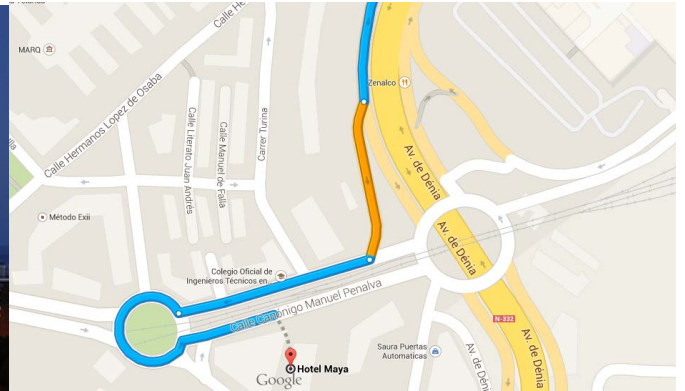

## Packing list for camp

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 useful information

Every day participants must wear appropriate sports clothing and extra clothes to change into for the language school and Alicante city centre. It is forbidden to wear swimsuits on the street.

**WORKOUT GEAR FOR 1 WEEK**

- 5 T-Shirts and 5 gym shorts
- 5 pairs of socks
- 2 pairs of basketball shoes (new shoes are not a good idea; you will get blisters and not be able to train)
- 1 sweatshirt or 1 tracksuit (just in case it gets colder, although this is rare in Alicante)
- Ankle, knee and wrist supports or any other protective gear
- Protective tape for strapping body parts (i.e. fingers)
- Compeed Blisters
- Creams or gels used to warm up muscles, if applicable
- Small toiletries kit to bring to the basketball court

**DAILY CLOTHES FOR 1 WEEK**

- Shorts, trousers, T-Shirts
- 1 fleece jacket or sweater
- Plenty of socks and underwear.
- Pyjamas / sleepwear
- 2-3 swimsuits, sun hat
- Shoes or sandals plus flip-flops for the shower, swimming pool and beach
- Sunglasses and sun protection appropriate for skin type with high protection factor (30 - 50 factor)
- Insect repellent
- Towels for the swimming pool and beach (3 medium-size towels). It is compulsory to bring at least one towel because the room towels cannot be taken out of the hotel.
- For missing towels in the hotel, there is €25 fee

**VALUABLES**

Zador cannot be responsible for valuables brought to camp. We strongly discourage bringing any valuables. Although the world does not stop if you are without a computer for a few days, there is a computer area available and there is free WIFI access at the hotel and at the school.

**DOCUMENTS, MEDICINE**

- Passport (original and 2 copies) plus 2 passport photos
- Medication, if needed, in its original container, along with the explicit dosage. A signed medical release form should accompany all prescription medication (in English or Spanish). Please be sure to bring a medical certificate to camp and submit it with the photograph upon arrival.
- First aid kit with plasters/band-aids, ibuprofen, paracetamol or other medicine that may be necessary.
- Parental Permission.
- Health Statement & Medical Waiver
- If the camper wears glasses or contacts, bring 2 pairs of glasses and sufficient contact lens cleaner.

**OTHER ITEMS**

**FOR THE LANGUAGE LESSONS**

- Pocket dictionary & notebook, pens/pencils, etc.

**OTHER ITEMS**

- Hairdryer (available at the room but not at the basketball facilities)
- Backpack for the training sessions and off-campus activities and excursions.
- Camera and batteries
- Mobile phone (and charger) /calling card
- Laundry bag for wet or dirty clothing labelled with the name
- Laundry bags labelled (one for color clothes and another for with clothes in case participant contracts the laundry service).

**POCKET MONEY**

Students do not have much time to spend money during the day, except on ice cream or snacks before lunch and souvenirs, T-shirts or presents on Saturday and Sunday during the excursion to an adventure park. Therefore, they do not need a lot of pocket money. We suggest approximately €10-15 per day. If the student needs funds they may be sent by Western Union (not by bank transfer to ZADOR's account).

## How can I enrol my child on the camp

Complete the online registration form:

- If there is more than one participant, please complete one form for each.
- Please check that you have completed all the items with \* -Otherwise, it is impossible to submit the form.
- After submitting the form, the website becomes blank and a message will appear at the top of the screen beginning with: "We have already received your registration..." indicating that the information has been saved in our database.
- Within two working days you will receive an email with the camp price including all the services requested and instructions on how to make the payment. You can either pay a deposit or the payment in full.
- The registration is not valid until we receive the payment in full. Participants will be placed on a first-come, first-served basis after receiving registration forms and payments. Final payments are due by April 1st.
- For the bank transfer, please include the registration code and participant's name, and please send a copy of receipt by fax or email.
- Once the enrolment form and a copy of the receipt have been received, we will send a confirmation email with the documents to be completed and returned before camp: Health Statement & Medical Waiver and Parental Permission Form. The Camp Rules and a link to complete a special form for campers regarding arrival and departure times will also be provided.
- 1 week before the camp begins, a camp handbook and the insurance policy will be provided.

## What forms do I need to fill out for the camp?

- Health Statement & Medical Waiver
- Parental Permission Form
- Other: 2 photos and arrival and departure information form

## What is your refund policy

- Once enrolled, there are no refunds. We recommend purchasing a cancellation policy.
- If for any reason you have to cancel before the final payment date, we will issue a camp voucher for all camp fees paid except the registration fee. This voucher is valid for the camp in the following year, and it is only transferable to an immediate family member. Refunds will only be given with the purchase of a Cancellation Policy.
- If a participant decides to travel during the period of the reservation and he/she does not attend some lessons or training sessions, no refund will be given.
- After the camp has started, no refund will be given in case of the camper withdrawing for family, personal or disciplinary reasons before the end of the camp.
- If the programme is cancelled by ZADOR, the full amount received will be refunded.

## What does the cancellation policy cover?

- If you want to be covered by the cancellation policy, you must purchase the policy for each payment.

## What does my tuition include?

- Room —twin or triple room— and full board (day campers only receive lunch and snacks in the training sessions)
- 1 Zador Basketball Camp T-shirt per week
- 12.5 hours language lessons per week
- 18-20 hours basketball training per week
- Personal coach evaluation
- Free time Activity Programme
- Travel, medical, accident and civil liability insurance

## Is the camp in a safe area? Are campers supervised?

- Yes to both questions. The hotel is North of Alicante, in a quiet and safe neighbourhood, near the beach and the Sports Halls. If Basketball Camp participants have hotel accommodation, they are highly supervised. Only during their free time or during the time to rest can they be in the common rooms or watching TV without camp counsellors, who remain available in the building.
- Campers must participate in all scheduled on-campus and off-campus activities, for which there are always adult supervisors.
- Campers cannot leave the camp premises alone. Only campers can go out alone with prior parental permission.

## How many players are in the same room?

- The majority of rooms are twin rooms, although there are several triple rooms.
- Single rooms are available on request.

## How do I handle roommate requests?

- There is a question on the enrolment form where you can specify if the camper is travelling with a companion and write the companion's name. If they are the same gender, we can accommodate them together.

## Can parents join the Basketball Camp?

- If you want to come with your children and are interested in languages, you can have a Spanish course in the morning and enjoy your holidays in Alicante. We can also suggest various hotels and activities. Please feel free to ask for further information about Spanish programmes for families.
- If a basketball player comes with a brother, sister or friends and they prefer to take part in another sports camp, they can. You can review the other Sports Camps in Alicante on our website or ask for the brochure on the Tennis, Sailing, Windsurfing or Golf camps.

### Is there accommodation available before or after the Camp?

- Yes, this is possible because the tennis, sailing, windsurfing and golf camps are from June 28 to August 20, and therefore there will already be adult supervisors at the hotel.
- Additional accommodation is available at an extra cost, but the camper may have to change his/her room at the hotel.
- The extra cost depends not only on the accommodation price but also on the activities scheduled for the extra days, as participants cannot be alone in the hotel.

### Is there a laundry service provided?

- The hotel has a laundry service.
- 2-week campers can contract an optional laundry service (€6 per 5 kilos). A laundry company takes the clothes on Thursday and will receive the clothes on Saturday. This service is only available if participants have their clothes labelled and inside laundry bags.

### Are the campers placed into groups based on age or ability?

- Both. Coaches first divide campers into groups based on age. Then campers are evaluated by staff as they go through a series of skill-testing drills.

### What are the ratios between staff and participants?

- At the training sessions we typically have 6-8 players per coach, plus additional staff on campus, including trainers, directors and assistants.
- At the language school, there are 7 students per classroom.

### Are all fees included in the camp price?

- Yes, except arrival or departure transfer services, lunch on the first day for early arrivals, lunch on the last day for late departures, optional laundry service, and personal expenses (beverages, ice-creams, etc.).
- All entrance tickets for activities are included in the price.

### What is the best time for phone calls?

- Although mobile phones are not forbidden at the camp, they will not be allowed at training sessions or in language classes, and their use may be regulated. Please also be aware of the possibility that phones may run out of battery, break or be lost.
- Campers have free time at: 8:00 to 9:00, 14:30 to 16:00 and 21:30 to 22:00. Please arrange suitable calling times with your son/daughter.
- Parents, please note: If your son/daughter has a mobile phone, please avoid calling every day to "check if everything is ok." Among the educational merits of a teenager attending the camp is the experience they gain of being "away from home." Furthermore, if you are based abroad, it is important that you avoid night-time phone calls by taking into account the time difference with Spain. Please also be aware that your children will be extremely busy during their time at the camp.
- All campers will be able to call home on the day they arrive at the camp.
